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(54) Title: COMBINATION FOR TREATING MALARIA COMPRISING 3-CHLORO-4-(4-CHLOROPHENOXY) ANILINE AND ARTESUNATE

(57) Abstract:

The present invention discloses an anti-malarial composition comprising aniline and artesunate. The composition has a suitable synergistic action against malaria when administered orally to humans due to their combined active components. In vitro semi-automated micro-dilution assay is used to determine the drugs'  $IC_{50}$  values while Peters' 4-day in vivo test is used to determine the drug's chemo-suppressive effect on P. berghei. EDso values are determined by linear regression using version 5.5 of Statistica, 2000 and one-way analysis of variance at 95% confidence level. A combination of 1.1 ng/ml of artesunate ( $IC_{50}$  2.4ng/ml on  $W_2$ ) and 3.3 ug/ml of 3-chloro-4-(4-chlorophenoxy) aniline ( $IC_{50}$  8.7~glml on  $W_2$ ) is capable of inhibiting 50% growth of W2 and a combination of 0.8 ng/ml of artesunate ( $IC_{50}$  1.6ng/ml on 3D7) and 2.6~g/ml of3-chloro-4-(4-chlorophenoxy) aniline ( $IC_{50}$  7.lJ.lglml on 3D7) is able to inhibit 50% growth of3D7. The combination is nontoxic and effective in control malaria.
